Thus, you may apply such formulas on interior or exterior walls, furniture, or masonry. There are specific solutions for metallic surfaces, especially those meant to protect such surfaces from corrosion or damage of any other kind. Paint for metallic surfaces is very quick to dry.

Before selecting your preferred solutions for metallic surfaces, consider the ability to withstand high temperature especially for radiators, boilers etc. Such surfaces may be very hot for some formulas.
