- Large sized T-square. It is required for measuring as well cutting of drywall.

- a plastic/steel corner tool

- Two knives: 4" & 10". These are essential for taping purpose. In fact, they are also used for finishing the drywall

- A proper container is required to create the mixture. TO avoid rusting effect, always opt for stainless steel containers.

- Some assorted brushes, tape, and clothes

Without the best type of materials, drywalling will not take place suitably. To start with, the movement should be from top. Then slowly, it should be preceded towards the bottom. Make sure that very little or no space is left in between boards. In case of any mistake, it can be fixed using sanding process.
