Computer problems are inevitable, but the diagnostic and troubleshooting approach can make a difference. Induction of the Acer eRecovery Management can be seen as the same endeavor of the brand to isolate itself from the crowd. Take a tour through the article, and discover how you can fix Windows booting problems or the dreaded "BOOTMGR is missing", or blue screen or black screen errors on your own, provided the problem isn't hardware related.

There can be different causes behind the scene provoking Windows 7 to shut down or restart unexpectedly. Corrupted or misconfigured Windows Files, hard drive and operating system upgrade issues, corrupt hard drive sectors, an outdated BIOS, damaged or loose IDE cables, viruses and spyware infection are a few to mention. At times, your machine misses the connectivity with the hard drive or may go wrongly connected with any other hard drive or flash drive to boot, thereby flashing up the error message : "Windows has been shut down to prevent damage to your computer" on the system screen. This also would apply to media on an optical drive or floppy drive that you're trying to boot from. Instead of calling on the Acer Help Number, it would be worth to go with the following troubleshooting steps. However, give preference to the built-in Windows tools ahead of the Acer's troubleshooting tool.

☛ Restarting the PC can sometimes bring amazing result. The BOOTMGR error could be a fluke.

☛ Check all external connectivity features like your optical drives, USB ports, and floppy drives for media. Often times, the "BOOTMGR is Missing" error will appear if your PC is trying to boot to a non-bootable disc, external drive, or floppy disk.

☛ Unplug and then re-connect all data cables. At times loose or malfunctioning power or controller cables can stem up the booting issues. Try replacing the PATA or SATA cable if you suspect it might be faulty.

☛ Did you know the Windows-built in repair feature i.e. Windows System Recovery Options? Not yet? Discover it then, press and hold the F8 key as your computer restarts till you land to the Windows logo screen. Wait for the Advanced Boot Options screen, and then use the Repair button to perform the startup repair task.

☛ Make sure that the BIOS platform, which instructs the machine as how to use a drive, holds the correct settings for the hard-drive. There's usually an Auto setting in BIOS for hard disk and optical drive configurations which is usually a safe bet if you're not sure what to do.

☛ Updating the Acer's motherboard's BIOS can also fix the system issues.

☛ Lastly, you can think of reinstalling the Windows to terminate all problems.

Although, the steps mentioned are quite simple and easy, you can seek assistance from Acer customer support to accomplish the job successfully.

Unfortunately, if you are nowhere, Acer's Windows recovery tool that I discussed in the beginning can be a good alternative. Restart the computer in order to get hands on the tool. When the Acer logo appears, press the left Alt, and the F10 keys. Load the Acer eRecovery Management and follow the on-screen prompts to address the prevailing issues instantly. Remember that the system may boot several times during the process.
