Firstly, you can decide to go for a compatible toner cartridge. These cartridges are brand new though they are manufactured by third party companies. Supposing you intend buying, let's say, low cost Epson ink, a Toner Cartridge would be right for you. These cartridges are usually made to a very high standard like the original manufacturers standards but in the Ink Prices, the Ink Toner UK is cheaper.

Also, you can as well buy a manufactured inkjet cartridge. This is a used and refilled cartridge, though, you should be aware that there is no guarantee for quality if you are taking a chance with this one.

Finally, you can as well pick the option of refilling the cartridges yourself. Refilling can be the cheapest option but you might get yourself messed up with the ink. In addition, refilling your cartridges means that you'll be doing it with a generic ink which might not augur well with your printer.
