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When selecting tiles for the house, bear in mind that selecting appropriate materials to suit the architectural design of a structure is vital. Materials such as porcelain, fired clay, ceramic, glass, metal, stone, and cork are soon after included into tiles that replaced baked clay bricks as roofing parts. Nowadays, they've become the best example for modern day application on almost any part of the house: from walls, floors, shower areas, and even tabletops.

Decorative tile works are distinct from mosaic. Decorative tile works are made of intricately placed tiles that consists of geometric patterns and forms. Ancient examples of these are the tiles at the Ishtar gate in Babylon where they designed bas relief of aurochs with lapis lazuli tiles.

Mosaics, on the other hand, are pieces of colored tiles, glass, stone, or other materials that are fixed in such a manner that they collectively form an image. Small pieces of roughly cut cubic glass, stone, or other materials called tesserae are employed to produce a pattern or picture. During the ancient times, especially the Byzantine era where Christianity has propagated, people used mosaics to adorn significant structures, mostly churches. They embellished walls upon walls with mosaics representing God and the lives of their venerated saints. One example of mosaic is the Christ Pantocrator from Hagia Sophia found in Turkey.

Today, similar tiling techniques are still employed, although there are technological developments that triggered the convenience of making and applying these decorative materials to homes and other structures. Tile mosaic mesh is easy to install thanks to its mesh underside that can be easily affixed to the wall by cement or grout; it's ideal for bathroom walls or kitchen backsplash. A number of them are produced out of Spanish marble, glass, or ceramic tiles.

Stone mosaic tiles are tiles that may be created from genuine stone or may be synthetically made to look like it. They can be installed in practically any space, in either exterior or interior parts of the house, to lend an earthy feel and appeal. They can also be manufactured out of stone cutouts or shaves.

Spaces that need a clean and crisp tile treatment might call for designs that apply a white hexagon tile, but they can be prone to dirt and might call for additional maintenance than any colored tiles. These tiles are offered as earthenware, polished, stoneware, or even glazed.
