The pawn is the most troublesome of the lot when it comes to attacking and defending a territory. In general, if you are playing with white pieces, it would be good to go all-out from the very first move. Attacking wins you more games than defending. And when you are playing with black piece, it would be good to set a solid foundation before switching gears and going on the attacking mode.

Talking about defense, one simple yet beneficial strategy to win a game is to make your opponent go on the defensive mode. If you have adopted the above steps then you will be able to adapt this strategy with ease. The more pressure you put on your opponent, the tougher life becomes for him or her. The more aggressive you play, the more is the chance for the opponent to falter. For every pawn or piece he loses while defending, the game will slowly start drifting in your favor. As a general tip, I would advise the beginners to learn by watching the tournament matches that you can see in sports channels using any of the popular cable services such as the one powered by Charter Cable.

The final and most important strategy to win a chess game for beginners is to attack the weak pawns. When you are on the attacking mode, your opponent's focus will be on protecting his king's side.
