Granada, a famous capital city situated in an autonomous Andalusian community, derives its name from the name of the province that it belongs to! These mountains are perfect for climbing, excursions, hiking and skiing. Winter sports are organized by the local tourist departments during the winter seasons.

The beach has a long history according to which, Javea was a popular port for both Moors and Romans. It is said that Romans used this port for fishing and they later started commerce and trade from Javea. Now, this small town has become a popular tourist spot and it is also known for its beautiful climate free from pollution.

There is a world famous art museum known as La Alhambra, situated in the regal fort of King Carlos V. This art gallery exhibits outstanding forms of Moorish art, Spanish ceramics, metal work and Hispano architecture dating back to approximately 9th to 15th century. Wood and plaster works in oriental Moorish art is a treat for history lovers!

Granada is inhabited by a far extending coastline which encloses popular beaches like Costal del Sol Malaga, Costa Tropical and Costa de Almeria. They boast their warm Mediterranean climate, bright sunshine, tropical fruits, surrounding lush green valleys, pristine waters, beach sports and beach side lounges that offer a dazzling shade of carefree Spanish lifestyle.

Any reference to this city is incomplete without writing an account on Nevada National Park which has been declared as a world Biosphere Reserve and National Hunting Reserve by UNESCO in the year 1966. This area houses approximately 65 floral and faunal species. Adventurists can undertake safari trips, hunting trips, horse riding, mountain biking and long drives in this region.

Apart from engaging in all this stuff, if you have sufficient time to analyze the richness of Spanish history, you may visit old artifacts and ruins present in Granada.
