This Famous Airline was established in 2003 and owned by bengaluru based united Breweries Group.. There are two main hubs of the Kingfisher airlines first one at the Bengaluru International Airport in Bengaluru and second the international airports of Delhi and Kolkata.

Spice jet

Ahead of Indigo and kingfisher Spice jet comes in 3rd position in the low-cost airline category. This inexpensive airline headquartered in Gurgaon, India. It began service in May 2005 and by 2008, it was India's second-largest low-cost airline in terms of market share. SpiceJet flies to 22 destinations across India and Nepal.
